

Dr. Borba presents how to impart these key skills to kids—whether it's teaching toddlers how to comfort one another or going beyond the books to stand up to bullying. Audiences will learn why empathy gives the keys for future happiness and success, and practical ways to activate empathy to raise kids with compassion, courage, conviction to become social Changemakers and make a difference in our world.

Dr. Borba is the award-winning author of 23 books translated into 24 languages including *Nobody Likes Me*, *No More Misbehavior!*, *Don't Give Me that Attitude!*, *12 Simple Secrets Real Moms Know*, *Building Moral Intelligence*, *Emotion Builders*, *Parents Do Make A Difference*, *The Big Book of Parenting Solutions*, *The 6 to 8 of Bullying Prevention*, and *UNSELFIE: Why Empathetic Kids Succeed in Our All-About-Me World*.

She is a regular NBC contributor appearing 135 times on the TODAY show, featured on three Dateline specials as well as Dr. Phil, Dr. Oz, Dr. Drew, The View, NBC Nightly News, The Doctors, Fox News, The Early Show, CNN and others. Dr. Borba has had a wide range of speaking experience. She received a Doctorate in Educational Psychology and Counseling from the University of San Francisco, an M.A. in Learning Disabilities and B.A. from the University of Santa Clara, and earned a Ph.D. Teaching Credential from San Jose State University.
